Romantic Love – Deep seated need of the women Sexual Love – Deep seated need of the man

Romance (Atmosphere of the marriage)

- 1. Wives need consistent romantic experiences and expressions of our love.
 - Hugs/kisses/touches
 - Non-sexual hugs...
- 2. Studies show 80% of a wife's need is emotional not physical.
 - Candle-lit dinners...
 - Walk on the beach...
 - Stroll in the park...
- 3. Tell her you love her.
 - "I told you 40 years ago... I'll let you know if I change my mind" NO!
