Gardening the Heart – 6 Four Kinds of Ground

Mark 4:13-20 NKJV

- 1. WAYSIDE Ground around the field Mark 4:15 (NKJV)
 - Hard ground (hearts)
 - Satan gets it immediately! How?
 - Matthew 13:18-19 (NKJV)
 - They do not understand
 - 2 Corinthians 4:3-4 (NKJV)
 - Mark 4:12(ref)
- 2. STONY GROUND "no root in themselves" Mark 4:16-17 (NKJV)
 - They received the word with gladness (emotion)
 - Affection and persecution arises for the Words sake
 - Offended or stumble_(emotion)
 Offense is one of the many forms of unforgiveness (bitterness; anger...)
 - Learn to forgive quick! Psalms 119:165 (ref)
- 3. THORNY GROUND briers and thistles (thorn bush) Mark 4:18-19 (NKJV)
 - Three different weeds that choke good seeds
 - Cares of the world
 Philippians 4:6 "...be anxious for nothing, but in prayer and supplication with thanksgiving..."
 - The deceitfulness of riches
 Deceit? Make us happy...bring peace...joy...
 Mathew 6:33(ref)
 - Desire (lust) for other things
 Covetousness period!
 Hebrews 13:5(ref)/ Luke 12:15 (ref)
- 4. GOOD GROUND Mark 4:20 (NKJV)
 - <u>Hear</u> the word (understand it)
 - Accept it Embrace it as the final authority.
 - Bear fruit (act on it) 30 / 60 / 100 fold

TAKE AWAY

- 1. We choose to hear (<u>Ask, Seek and Knock</u>) "he that has an ear to hear, <u>let</u> him hear"
- 2. **Accept** or **reject** the truth (seed)
- 3. The Word (seed) changes us and our lives.
