

## No Limits With God – 7 “Humility”

James 4:5-10 (KJV)

James 4:10 .... Humble ourselves and God will lift us up

I Peter 5:2-6 (KJV)

I Peter 5:6 – humble ourselves and God will exalt us in due time

My job – humble myself

God’s job – exalt me

Pride = arrogance and false humility

(opposite ends of the same stick)

“self-centered”

“depends on self”

Humility = John 15:5 and Philippians 4:13

(opposite ends of the same stick)

“Christ-centered”

“Depends on Christ”

- John 15:5 = submission
- Philippians 4:13 = submission
- James 4:7 = submit to God....
- I Peter 5:5 = submit one to another

Deuteronomy 8:1-5 (Israel and submission)

Just as sure as you’ll experience a slow death without bread, so you will without God’s Word

Manna = eat and live, multiply and prosper

God’s Word = eat (obey, submit) live, multiply and prosper

God humbled them = submit and live!

Luke 2:48-52 (Jesus and submission)

Jesus submitted to His parents

Humility submits

vs. 52 – increase came

Matthew 2:15 (NLT) – “it should be done, for we must carry out all that is required.”

So John agreed to baptize him.

Matthew 8:5-13 (Roman centurion and submission)

(MSG) “ ... I’m a man who takes orders and gives orders.”

(NLT) “ .... I know this because I am under the authority of my superior officers, and I have authority over all my soldiers.”

- Humility involves submission
- Humility involves being under authority and exercising authority.

- Jesus was under the Father's authority and so He had authority

James 4:7 (KJV) Submit (under authority), resist (exercise authority)

I Peter 5:5-9 (KJV)

- Submit (one to another)
- Humble ourselves (under authority)
- Resist the devil (exercise authority)
