Romans 8:11 (NKJV)

- What is dead or dying (mortal) He brings to life
- God raises dead things to life (Romans 4:17)
 - $\circ~$ Spiritual Death
 - $\circ~$ Emotional Death
 - Relational Death
 - Physical Death

Revelation 1:17-18 (NKJV)

- 1. God <u>REACHES</u> Out For Us.

 - Luke 15:1-32 (ref)
 - Lost Sheep / Coin / Son
 - Genesis 3:9-10 ... "Adam where are? I heard your voice in the garden and I was afraid because I was naked and hid myself"
 - No one has gone too far...unreachable

- 2. God <u>RESCUES</u> Us.
 - Luke 19:10 "For the son of man is come to seek out and <u>SAVE</u> that which was lost."
 - He loves us...mess and all.
 - He accepts us the way we are and where we are.
 - Romans 5:8-10 (NKJV)
- 3. God <u>REDEEMS</u> Us Buys and brings us back to Him
 - Purchases us with his own blood.
 - o 1 Peter 1:18-19
 - We stand totally accepted as if we've never sinned.
 - Galatians 3:13 (ref)
- 4. God <u>RESTORES</u> Us
 - We all have issues STUFF
 - We are a work in progress.
 - Spirit is born again (converts)
 - Soul is being renewed (Disciples)
 - Body is saved by hope
 - Life transformed 2 Corinthians 3:18 / Romans 12:2
